Audrey, Charlotte, and I are spending this first week of June in Jackson Hole, Wyoming on vacation. It is, in my opinion, one of the most beautiful places in the lower 48 states. The Snake River runs alongside the Teton Mountain Range and Grand Teton National Park. These mountains rise up to their highest point at 13,776 feet above sea level. They are truly a magnificent sight to see.

One of the peaks or mountains in the range is called Rendezvous Mountain, and at the bottom is the Teton Village where the Jackson Hole Tram begins. This tram climbs 4,139 vertical feet to the top of Rendezvous Mountain in only 15 minutes. The trip on the way up is gorgeous. You have 360 degree views of the Snake River Valley, the entire Teton Range, and once you reach the top you can see into Idaho. Your entire perspective changes dramatically in 15 minutes. From the bottom where you can really only see trees and a part of the mountain range, to the top where your view is expanded a hundred fold.

For some, stepping on the tram can seem scary. They don't necessarily like heights, they think the tram might malfunction halfway up the mountain, or they are just comfortable staying on the ground. But they are missing so much! I think we can feel this way in our lives sometimes, and spiritually as well. We get in a place where we can't see the forest of our lives for the trees right in front of us. Our perspective gets blocked or stunted by the situations of life and the choices that we make.

It comes down to our perspective, and at times our vantage point. Spiritually, we can be on the ground and only see a small portion of what God wants to do in our lives and how God is involved. We might even be very comfortable staying right where we are with what we are able to see and how we interact with God. But, I believe for every one of us that God wants to continually help us have a new perspective on our own lives and what He wants to do in our lives.

If you are feeling like you have a "tree" in front of your face and need a new perspective I would encourage you to think about your vantage point on the situation, whatever the situation might be. It might be that you only need to take a few steps to the left or right to see around the tree. Or it might be that God wants to get you on a tram and take you high above everything to show you the big picture that is happening. Sometimes, having a "break-through" in your physical, emotional, relational, or spiritual life is just a change in perspective.

#### Would You Like To Be Baptized?








