At the time we were living in Wyoming, and I was also in the middle of completing my Master's Degree which meant we needed to stop halfway through the 6-hour drive for me to log on to my online video class. We found the tiny town of Walden, CO and a restaurant that offered free WIFI. After the class was over we took off and we were making great time, and I'm all about making great time when I'm driving!

After about 2 hours of progress down the road, I had this tiny feeling that maybe we weren't going the right direction. We had been talking, listening to music, enjoying the scenery and not really paying attention because we had basically been in a canyon the entire time with no side roads anywhere. So, we decided to check our old GPS unit that sometimes didn't work too great (this was before we had smartphones). Sure enough, we had taken a wrong turn as soon as we had left Walden. At this point in the journey our only real course of action was to continue on down the canyon, spitting us out in Ft. Collins, CO roughly 3 hours away from our intended destination. Needless to say, we called it a day, spent the night there and made it to Winter Park the next morning.

Not all progress is productive. Frantically trying to make "progress" in quicksand will only make your demise happen faster. Running around making "progress" in the forest if you are lost will only make you more lost. Moving forward just for the sake of moving forward is dangerous.

In life, there are times where we think we are making progress, yet we are either headed in the wrong direction, blindly moving forward, or steamrolling over anything that gets in our way. After fleeing Egypt, the Israelites were trapped on one side by the Red Sea and on the other side by the pursuing Egyptians. They wanted to make progress in getting out of this situation so much so, that their intended "progress" was going back to their life of slavery! Thankfully, Moses spoke the truth of God to the people saying, "Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. The Lord will fight for you, and <u>you have only to be silent</u>."

Progress in all areas of our life is crucial. We do not want to be stagnant, but we also do not want to run headlong with no caution into it either. Moses tells the Israelites to be silent, wait on God, let Him guide the progress. So, what area/areas in your life need some progress in? Is it spiritual progression in your walk with Jesus? Is it relational progression with your spouse and/or children? Is it physical progression with your health?

Whatever area it is, be still and listen for God's direction. Take time to hear, because as we see with the Israelites He will guide and provide. Then you can be sure that your progress will be productive. And you never know, God may part the "Red Sea" in your life so you can proceed forward in a way that was blocked before.
