Do you realize that dealing with temptation was part of God's plan? From the beginning Adam and Eve had that one tree they were not to eat from. God didn't tempt them, but the tempter, Satan, did and from that, sin came into our world. From the beginning Adam and Eve had other options, but they chose the tree they were not to eat of.

Today we are still faced with many temptations and the evil one would want us to yield our will to those temptations. Just as Adam and Eve had other options than eating of the forbidden fruit, we still have other options today. In fact God promises that there is away to escape that temptation. In 1 Corinthians 10:13, God promises us that all man kind faces temptation, and He will not allow us to be tempted beyond what we can bear. He promises us a way to escape temptations!

Corinthians 10:13: "No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it."

I have a Dayton parable that may apply: There was this trucker hauling a heavy load as he approached a steep grade that had a turn out for a brake check area. He decided that all was well with his equipment and continued on. As the grade got steeper he gained more speed and his brakes began to over heat and were not up to the task. A sign appeared, "Truck Escape Ramp 4 tenths of a mile", then another sign, "Escape Ramp 2 tenths of a mile". Then the ramp appeared but he pressed on. His decision lead to disaster. So don't be like that trucker and ignore the warning signs that cost him his life. There were signs along the way to prevent losing his life but he chose to ignore them because he thought he knew more than those who designed the highway.

God created the world and mankind. He knows when we are headed for disaster in our lives and provides a way to escape. It is up to us to realize God knows a better route to take and to escape the pitfalls of sin in our lives.

"But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it."

God has provided forgiveness for our sin through His Son Jesus Christ, but also wants us to avoid sin and take the safe path.
