## WORDS FROM OUR PASTOR

Have you heard of the term entropy? According to the dictionary the word can be used in physics regarding the thermodynamic quantities of a certain system that you are referring to. Not ready to jump into thermodynamics??? Me either... The dictionary also states that entropy is a: *lack of order or predictability; gradual decline into disorder.* The last definition is what I want to focus on for this article.

I'm sure that you have experienced this in one way or another in your life, or maybe you are going through entropy right now! If you made a "New Year's Resolution" there's an 80% chance that you are having a *gradual decline* in that resolution, as 80% of resolutions die by February. Did you know that we fight against entropy in the Christian life and in the Church as well?

In our walk with Jesus if we aren't staying connected with Him, praying, reading our Bible, etc... we can start to have our relationship go on a decline. The longer our relationship goes without intentional connection it can start to look like this:



This can also happen in the Church, where it is called *Ministry Entropy*. If we just leave things alone, they become less effective over time. What used to work great a few years ago just feels a little more tired. It's not that anything is bad or wrong, it's just not as effective. Our new Northwest Yearly Meeting Superintendent, Jim LeShana, made this statement last weekend at the Mid-Year Board Meetings, "The sign of a great church is that its vision is greater than its memories."
