**Bend Friends Church Report:** was provided by Pastor Jadon Ross he stated that Bend Friends began services on August 29 at the home of John & Rachel Baker and had 27 in attendance. Over the course of the next 6 weeks, we saw new people come through, and we began to pray about a larger place to gather. God provided Kevista Coffee Shop for our new location, and we moved services there beginning on October 17, 2021. That first Sunday we had over 40 in attendance with a good group from Metolius coming down to support the Church plant. Over the course of the last month and half there has been a core group of BFC folks that are committed to Jesus and to the plant. We are praying about next steps in discipleship, leadership training, continuing to get the word out about BFC, and more. Please continue to pray for BFC

<u>Christian Education Ministry Team Report:</u> Audrey Ross noted that we've held a couple of Parent's Night Out events (Oct. & Dec.). Children's Church is going well, and the new curriculum has been a good fit. We are planning and preparing for the Christmas Programs happening next week, and the kids are really excited. Christian Ed is needing some more volunteers to help with Children's Church so that we can split it into 2 age groups. We'd also love to see more help with the Youth Group age kids.

Women's Ministry Team Report: Audrey Ross provided the report for the Women's Ministry Team. Members are: K'Lynn Larson, Audrey Ross, Jennifer Hatfield, Augusta Davis and Kim Macy. We started Revelation women's bible studies in September. Wednesday morning group is led by Audrey Ross and have had many fun outings. Wednesday evening group led by Augusta Davis. Close to 30 women combined attending the study. We had 8 women attend the Friends Women's retreat in October at Twin Rocks. We had a movie night at the church. The Christmas sock exchange party went well with over 30 in attendance! We are busy planning our women's retreat at Ochoco Christian Conference Center Feb.25-27! Working on a birthday party dessert event. Planning a Supper 6 night and launched a "Faithful Friends" mentor program for the ladies. This turned out to be a learning process! We didn't do it justice and will revisit this soon.

**Missions Ministry Team Report provided by Gordon Wood:** Our church currently supports two missionary families. Lance and Megan Roberts have served in the Ukraine for approximately 10 years. This past year they have been on sabbatical at Discovery Bay Washington at the YWAM Campus. Their sabbatical has ended, and they were to return to the Ukraine in two months. This does not look promising, however, because of the predicted invasion by Russia. They thank all of us for our continued support during this time. Elizabeth Todd arrived in Jerusalem in November as a friend of Jesus and is living there. She says, "I still don't feel at home in this big city with its swirling undercurrents. But I find that the divine light studies me when, more than anything, the people of this restless city need a person of peace to walk among them. She has started her classes and they are going well. She also has a bicycle and can get around easier. She appreciates our prayers and support as she continues to be a light alongside the those she encounters.

Money raised from past Valentine's fundraisers will be given to Evangelical Friends Mission to use for missionary support since we don't have any future Mexico missions planned at this time. The amount of \$3500 will be used by EFM to support different missionary projects.

Stewardship Ministry Team Report provided by Pastor Jadon: Stewards members include Dan Quinn, Elaine Henderson, Andrew Mesquita, Ron Cummings, John Wilcox, Dean Larson, and Dubbie Stevens – Treasurer. - 2021 building improvements include sidewalk replacement, two new furnaces (two of the three were original), Parsonage carpet and flooring, security cameras purchased to support the Elders safety initiative, trauma and first aid kits installed. We had a property survey completed along with smaller projects and improvements. We were faced with an unexpected loss earlier this year with Sharon Brackett's passing. We lost a friend and a treasurer. With a lot of hard work and Dubbie's willingness to step up as treasurer, we were able to complete the transition. We had a successful and well attended workday in October. Perry and Andrew from the Stewards provided a special barbeque lunch to the 25-30 "workers". We hung new blinds, spread 4 loads of gravel, stained the deck and fence at the parsonage, and did miscellaneous cleanup projects inside and out. Dan Quinn identified and removed a wasp nest from the compost pile.

Stewards are working on an online giving program we are anticipating it will be rolled out to the congregation in January. The stewards worked with individual committees to finalize a 2022 budget. Most lines items are consistent with 2021 but do factor in inflation and those anticipated increases. The 2022 budget reflects the additions of a worship leader, associate pastor, and support for Bend Friends.

The stewards want to say thank you to our congregation. Thank you for the faithful giving of your financial resources. Thank you for the many volunteer hours which our congregation gave over this past year, much of it behind the scenes, to expand the Kingdom in Central Oregon and beyond.

Associate Pastor Report: Mario Mendoza gave his associate Pastor report. He has been meeting with different folks in Bend making connections through BFC. At Metolius, He's been coming and helping with the Supper & Study, doing a funeral for a family in Madras, and will be helping with Small Groups. He's going to be an advisor for Madras Cross Country & Track and helping lead events for the Madras Runners Club. I dream of a Church that can do both discipleship and outreach simultaneously so that they can be carry the message everywhere they go.

**Pastor Report:** Pastor Jadon Ross noted this has been a season of growth in the life of our Church. We have given birth to a new baby Church, Bend Friends. We have brought on additional staff members. We have seen our attendance and giving grow over the course of the last few months. (Thanks to each of you for your faithful giving!) We have seen people growing deeper in their relationship with Jesus, living by the Holy Spirit. And with growth comes growing pains, increased responsibilities, and an enemy that doesn't want to see us continue to spread the Gospel of Jesus in Central Oregon. We must keep on relying on Christ and the Holy Spirit to lead, empower, discipline, and guide us! As we read in Hebrews and as God keeps bringing back to me, "We are not of those who shrink back!"

# **Christian Education Ministry Team Highlights**

We have been blessed with an abundance of children attending children's church and in the nursery. With weekly numbers in the high 20's we decided to break children's church into two groups starting April 10. Our levels are 3 year olds to kindergarten/1st grade and 2nd grade through 5th grade. It is working well. Nursery is averaging 6-12 children. The older nursery children are loving going to the new class. We are grateful for our volunteers and love the new families coming in.

This last Sunday we had 26 in the older group. Our biggest challenge is finding enough help to run both groups. The younger group is starting a study on creation and will go through the old testament. The older group is finishing up the life of Christ and his disciples ministries then will start into a study on the Armor of God. We will have a full fledged study of the Armor of God with knights and castles for VBS July 26-29.

Youth group is meeting every other Sunday evening and are currently studying Job. They have a meal, read scripture, the youth ask questions to direct the conversation, then end the evening with games outside. They average 9 youth attending.
